FACILITY: Eight (8) lane 25-yard outdoor pool with cover will be used for warm up and competition. *Pool is enclosed by heavy tarp covering for rainy and/or cooler temperatures.*

WARM UP: Lane Assignments will be emailed after meet entries have been received.

EVENT FORMAT: Each swimmer may enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) individual events, and no more than three (3) relay events.

Each team is limited to no more than (2) relays per relay event, and each team is limited to no more than (2) swimmers per 500 Free event (under 7 min. please).

- OFFICIALS:** Please let us know if you have officials on your team available to assist.
- TIMERS:** Host will provide teams with timing assignments after all entries are received.
- PROGRAMS:** Heat Sheets will be provided for the coaches, officials, and timers. A PDF file of the heat sheet will be distributed to the teams after all entries are received. Meet will also be published on Meet Mobile.
- AWARDS:** None
- SCORING & RESULTS:** No Scoring. Unofficial results will be published on Meet Mobile and sent to teams after the conclusion of the meet.
- CONCESSIONS:** There will be no concessions. Please plan to bring food/water.
- HOSPITALITY:** Hospitality will not be available. Please plan to bring a snack and water.
- POOL DECK RESTRICTIONS:** Due to safety regulations, the swimming pool deck is closed during the entire meet to all persons except swimmers, coaches, safety marshals, officials, meet personnel, security and timers.

Meet Guidelines:

- Teams will be assigned a specific area for set up. Due to spacing, only limited bleacher space will be available. Some swimmers will require chairs or towels to sit on the pool deck. Please sit 6 feet apart in your area.
- This is an outdoor meet (the pool is covered). No spectator setup will be allowed inside the pool deck area. Spectators will have an outdoor (uncovered) grassy area available to set chairs in. There may also be limited chair space available on the walkway on the opposite side of the pool.
- Parents will not be allowed inside the pool deck (covered area) unless they are a part of the meet personnel, official, coach, or volunteer team.
- Swimmers will be required to wear their suits to and from the meet. Locker rooms for changing will not be available.
- Teams will be allowed restroom access only.

- No concessions / No hospitality food provided. Please pack accordingly.
- All meet staff, athletes and coaches will wear masks at their discretion.
- The meet referee and starter will pause between heats and events, allowing ample time for athletes to exit the pool and competition area before calling for the next heat.
