Dear Coaches,

We are glad you have chosen to attend the Charger Relays on Thursday, February 8th, 2024. Due to construction at BISD Stadium the meet will be hosted at Champion High School. Our facility at Champion does not allow us to conduct pole vault. **Pole vault will be conducted off site at BISD Stadium. We will have a driver that will drive all pole vault contestants to BISD Stadium at 2:30 pm. JV and varsity girls will vault at the same time and JV and varsity boys will vault at the same time. When the pole vault is complete all contestants will be shuttled back to Champion High School for the remainder of the meet.** Our apologies for any inconvenience this may provide.

The following schools will compete at our meet this year: **Boerne, Champion, Champion B, Churchill, Harlan, New Braunfels, O'Connor, Reagan, Somerset, New Braunfels Canyon**

Coaches meeting will be in the concession stand at the north side of the stadium at 2:15 pm

We ask that each school provide coaches to help work the meet. You will see the workers list on the last page. We will have a worker meeting at 2:30 pm in the concession stand.

We will provide a meal for all workers and coaches. Meal tickets will be given out at the coaches meeting. Meals can be picked up at the concession stand.

Our National Anthem will be played at 2:55 pm. All field events and 3200-meter run will begin at 3:00 pm. Running events will begin approximately 20 minutes following the completion of field events.

Each varsity field contestant will have 4 attempts and each JV contestant will have 3 attempts. Implements will be pooled and must remain for the duration of contest. All field events will be run without a time schedule once they begin. As soon as one event is finished, we will move to the next one. We will give about 10-15 minutes after each field event before starting the next division. Please have athletes warmed up and ready to compete before the event begins.

*Starting heights can be adjusted if necessary.

The meet will be finals only where athletes will be running against time. Running events will be run without a time schedule once they begin. Contestants will be timed using a FAT system provided by Hill Country Timing.

We will use Mile Split heating and scoring for our meet. **All entries are due by 6pm Tuesday February 6th.** Scratches and adds will be done by email after the initial heat and lane assignments are released.
